There he led development of unique programs for management of pain disorders including low back pain, a network of outpatient rehabilitation facilities, and comprehensive rehabilitation programs. He also developed a utilization management model for a managed care company and developed outpatient utilization review guidelines for a capitated physical therapy network.

He is a member of the American Academy of Pain Medicine, the American Academy of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, and the American Pain Society. He also has experience as a workers' compensation utilization review physician. His memberships have included the Greater Boston Chapter of the National Spinal Cord Injury Association, the Spinal Cord Injury Standards Committee of the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities, and the Medical Advisory Committee of the New England Chapter of the National Multiple Sclerosis Society.
